
How to find us

Maidstone Museum is located in the centre of Maidstone, easily accessible from all transport links.

BY CAR:

From the M20, take Junction 6 and head towards Maidstone town centre and Maidstone East train station. Follow the brown heritage signs.

PARKING:

Fremlin Walk multi-storey car park is well-signposted from Fairmeadow (A229) and is opposite the Museum. There are on-street disabled bays in Station Road, outside the Museum.

TRAIN:

Our nearest train station is Maidstone East located at the rear of the Museum, just a 2 minute walk through Brenchley Gardens.
