Activity 1; Play a game of hide and seek with someone in your family.

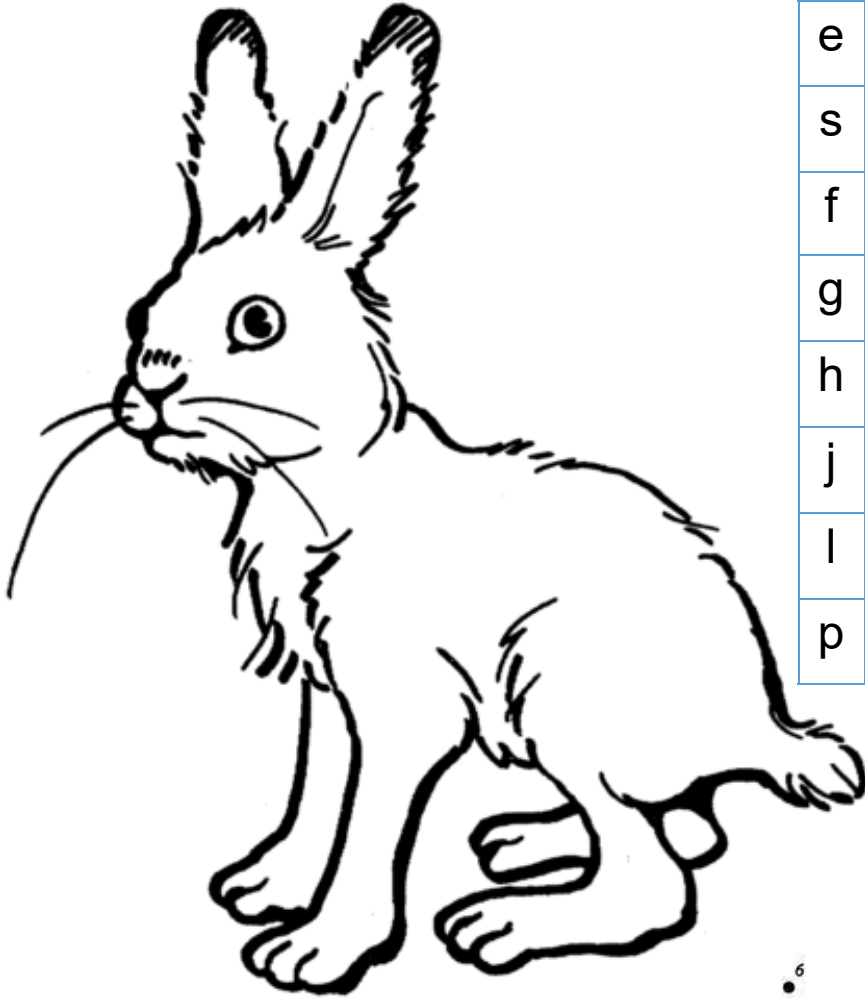
Activity 2; On the next page there are 4 fun activities for you to do, including a dot to do and a wordsearch. Have fun!
