Bead Bracelet Instructions



- Colour the triangles using coloured pencils. Tip; the edges and point of the triangle will be seen on your bead but the centre won't.
- Cut along the lines to create triangles 5 or 6 will make a good size bracelet. Use the ret to make your necklace.
- 3. Starting at the wide end of the triangle, wrap it around a pencil, coloured side up, and glue the pointed end to the rest of the paper roll. Slide carefully off of the pencil.
- 4. Thread onto elastic, string or wool.
- Repeat until you have made and threaded enough beads to go around your wrist. Use the rest on your necklace.
- 6. Knot the two ends of the elastic/string together.
- 7. Now you can wear your bracelet and necklace.
