Activity; Spike would like you to plant some seeds and look after them until they grow. Keep a seed diary, keeping record of when and how the seeds grow. It would be great to see pictures of you planting the seeds and then come back and show us how they are growing. Seeds can take anything from a few days to weeks to start to grow.

Spike's top tips;

- Use unusual containers – old boots, egg shells, tea pots, old pans all make for great pots
- Have everything to hand – compost/soil, seeds, watering can
- Don't over water the seeds/plants
- Protect seeds and seedlings from frost. Start them on a windowsill or in a greenhouse.




