

## Venue Hire - Library

The Library offers a warm, welcoming and inspirational venue. Museum collections are on display including books, busts and artworks by the local artist Albert Goodwin (1845-1932). As a member of the Royal Watercolour Society, Goodwin exhibited extensively, showing nearly 800 works. He was championed by Ruskin and trained with the Pre-Raphaelite brotherhood.

**Capacity:** Suitable for up to 40 delegates (including organiser) in a variety of layouts

## Venue Hire – Glass Room

The Glass Room offers a light, bright space with air conditioning and automatic blinds. Museum collections are on display including items from our Japanese, Chinese and Ethnography collections.

**Capacity:** Suitable for up to 18 delegates (including organiser) boardroom style only

**Availability:** 10am – 4pm - Wednesday - Friday
